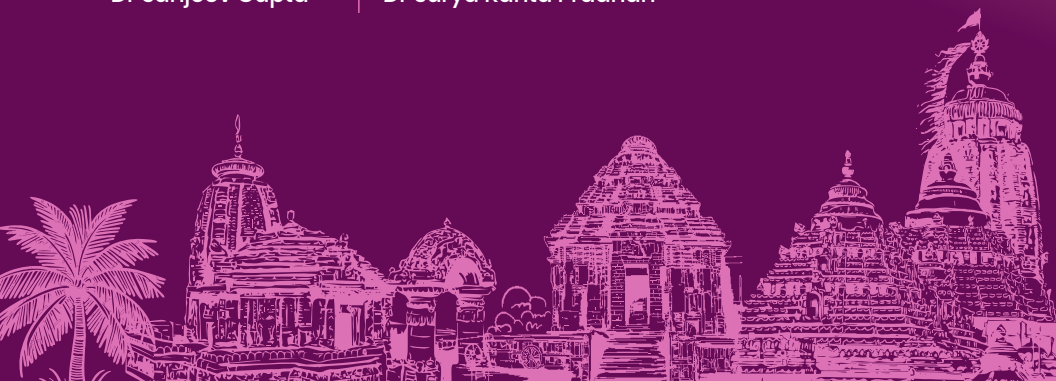

## National Faculties



### Dr Manoj M P

Dr Manoj M P is the Chief Consultant and Head of the Cochlear Implant Unit at MESIARC ENT Hospital, Calicut, Kerala. He pioneered Kerala's first comprehensive ENT–Audiology–Habilitation unit and co-initiated the state's first cochlear implant program in 2002. In 2006, he founded the MESIARC ENT Institute, now recognized as one of the most advanced ENT hospitals with cutting-edge surgical, diagnostic, and audiology facilities. He has performed over 2,700 pediatric cochlear implants, including a large number in children below two years of age, and leads India's largest bilateral cochlear implant program. He is widely respected for his clinical outcomes, academic contributions, and lifelong commitment to hearing rehabilitation and child-centric care.



### Dr. Shankar B Medikeri

Dr. Shankar B Medikeri is a senior ENT surgeon and cochlear implant specialist with over 40 years of experience in otolaryngology and 20 years in implantation otology. He is the Director of Medikeri Super Specialty ENT Center, Bengaluru, and has extensive teaching experience at MS Ramaiah Medical College and Sri Siddhartha Medical College. He secured a Gold Medal in ENT during MBBS and stood First Rank in MS (ENT) from the University of Bombay. Dr. Medikeri has been awarded prestigious qualifications including FICS and FRCS. He has served as Past President of AOI Bangalore, AOI Karnataka, and the Cochlear Implant Group of India. He has mentored numerous ENT surgeons in cochlear implant surgery across India and abroad. His areas of expertise include deafness surgery, cochlear implantation, endoscopic sinus surgery, and micro laryngeal surgery. Currently, he serves as the President of the Association of Otolaryngologists of India for 2024–25.



### Dr. Mohnish Grover

Dr. Mohnish Grover is a distinguished otologist and cochlear implant surgeon, currently serving as Senior Professor and Additional Superintendent at SMS Medical College, Jaipur. He is the Ex-Secretary of the Cochlear Implant Group of India and President-Elect of the All India Rhinology Society, reflecting his leadership in national professional bodies. With over 1,300 cochlear implants performed, he has also mentored numerous cochlear implant centers across India and abroad. His academic contributions include more than 100 publications, notably the widely referenced SMS Classification for cochlear malformations. He is the Chief Editor of the Textbook of Radiology for Cochlear Implants (Thieme) and Editor of Advances in Implantation Otology (Springer).



### Dr. Vishwambhar Singh

Dr. Vishwambhar Singh is a senior academic otorhinolaryngologist and Professor in the Department of Otorhinolaryngology at the Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University. He holds an MS (ENT) from IMS BHU and has served in several key national and institutional roles, including Ex-Vice President UPAOI, Secretary AOI Varanasi, and Governing Body Member UPAOI, along with academic and administrative responsibilities at AIIMS Patna and NMC. Dr. Singh has authored 57 publications, including books on tinnitus, deafness assessment, and COVID-19 challenges. His contributions have been recognized with multiple honors, including appreciation from the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and the Scroll of Honour from the Governor of West Bengal.
